Submit your application

Submitting an application lets us know you are interested in pursuing your degree with us. You'll need:

- A completed application. Our application is quick, easy, and free. Submit it today.
- College transcripts. Whether you took one course or 10 courses at a previous institution, or took a college course in high school, we need all of the transcripts. Submit unofficial or official copies to begin your application review process.
- Letter of recommendation from an advisor or teacher.

Apply for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)

■ Submit all official final transcripts

In order for your credits from other colleges to transfer to Russell Sage, you'll need to have all official transcripts sent to us. You can transfer up to 75 credits. Reach out to the registrar office at your previous institution(s) to have your transcripts sent over.

Submit your deposit

Securing your spot in the upcoming class is easy — submit your deposit at sage.edu/deposit. You'll need your Student ID (located on your acceptance letter and email).

Classes start on Tuesday, January 22, 2025, for the spring 2025 semester. Class registration begins on November 18, 2024, so secure your spot today to get the classes you want!
